	School visit to provide Historical character workshop.

HAZARD NUMBER	HAZARD DESCRIPTION	CONTROLS IN PLACE TO REDUCE RISK.
1	Workshop provider exhibits COVID 19 symptoms or has been in contact with a person who has tested positive potentially spreading the virus.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The workshop will be cancelled if the provider is feeling unwell or showing any symptoms of COVID 19.</li> <li>The provider will self-isolate and cancel the workshop if informed of any contact he with a person who has tested positive for COVID 19.</li> <li>Temperature will be taken prior to visit</li> <li>Provider will be willing to have their temperature taken on entry to the premises.</li> <li>A list of schools visited by the provider in the previous 14 days will be available.</li> </ul>
2	Contact with adults or children allows virus to spread.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A visor or mask will be worn by the provider in communal areas</li> <li>Social distancing will be maintained between provider and the staff and children.</li> <li>Children will be given clear instructions to ensure that they understand how to social distance throughout the workshop,</li> <li>Provider will eat lunch in isolation either within their vehicle or assigned location on the premises.</li> <li>Provider will request that the workshop will take place in a well-ventilated space to ensure good circulation of air.</li> </ul>
3	Surfaces touched around the school become contaminated by the virus.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Provider will enter and exit the school through designated access points.</li> <li>Provider will carry out regular handwashing and sanitising, especially on arrival at the school and throughout their time on site.</li> <li>Movement around the school; will be limited.</li> </ul>
4	Virus is spread through use of resources	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Resources provided will not have been used in another setting 72 hours prior to the workshop</li> <li>Resources will be prepared 72 hours before the workshop and the provider will not touch the resources during the workshop.</li> <li>Any 'hard' resources used will be wiped with anti-bacterial wipes before use by another group.</li> <li>Activities will be adapted to minimise the use of resources by multiple children within a session</li> </ul>
5	Provider becomes unwell and has potentially spread the virus during visit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If the provider develops any symptoms up to 14 days after the visit, the school will be informed.</li> <li>When a subsequent COVID19 test is taken the school will be informed of the outcome.</li> </ul>
